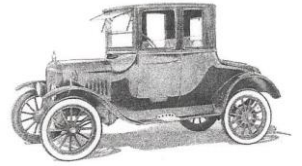

## Cen-Tex Tin Lizzies Enjoy 2016 Kingsbury

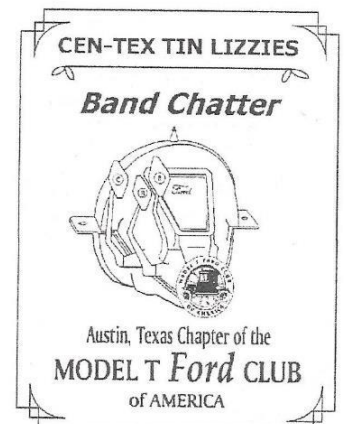

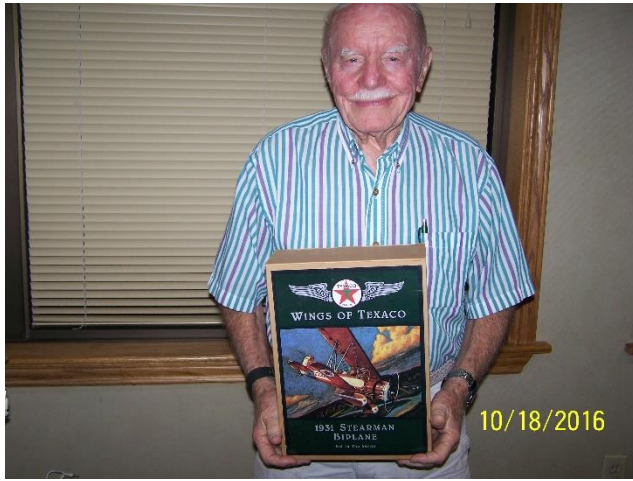
